2	9:15- 10:00	Proposed Basin Boundary Modification – Upper Ventura River Groundwater Basin Jordan Kear, Kear Groundwater	The Ventura River Water District has submitted an initial notification of proposed modifications to the Upper Ventura River groundwater basin boundary. As discussed in our January Council meeting, this proposed basin boundary modification is based on more recent science and maps than the current California Department of Water Resources map of the basin.
